You are recommended to take all courses in one group before you can move onto the next group. You may take all courses in each group together, or spread them out over several semesters, depending on whether you are a full-time or part-time student.

HSC 4800 Pre-Internship – (offered Fall, Spring & Summer; **MUST** be completed the semester prior to HSC 4814 Community Service Internship) *Enforced Prereqs: HSC 3713, All Program Prereqs AND you must be admitted as a Community Health student.*

GROUP FOUR

HSC 4814 Community Service Internship (offered Fall, Spring, & Summer) – *Enforced Prereqs: All general ed, prerequisites/requisites, core, major and minor requirements must be completed with a "C" or better prior to internship, with a minimum UNF GPA of 2.0. Only elective courses may be completed with internship. Students must petition to take an elective with internship.*
