Take behind the scene engineering and environmental tours of Glen Canyon Dam, Navajo Generating Station, Tuba City Disposal Site, Oak Creek Canyon, Flagstaff Landfill, Open Pit Mine, and Walnut Canyon cultural sites. Tour the facilities with experts from the Bureau of Reclamation, Dept of Energy, Northern AZ University, Salt River Project, and the City of Flagstaff. Complete field exercises in topographic mapping/siting, geologic mapping, stream flow measurement, air pollution, archaeology, and groundwater management. Participate in special day trips to area national parks !!
