## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

Undergraduate courses are taught **in Spanish.**

*Note: You need a MINIMUM of 2 years of college level Spanish plus one 3000/4000 level conversation course to enroll in classes taught in Spanish.*

## ACADEMIC CALENDAR

### Fall semester

- August - November
- Finals are held in December

### Spring semester

- March - June
- Finals are held in early August

**In the Southern Hemisphere seasons are opposite those in the United States!**

**Austral University's academic year starts in March and ends in November. Summer break is December through February.**

## LANGUAGE PROGRAMS

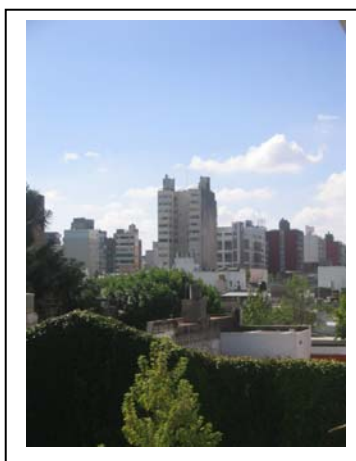
There are no programs for learning Spanish through the Austral University. But, tutorials and meeting can be arranged to improve your oral skills.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

**Housing options are significantly cheaper than in Jacksonville!**

- Shared apartment with other exchange students
- Home stay with a local family

You can share an **apartment** with other international and exchange students from Austral University. Rent is approximately \$130 - \$140 per month depending on location and accommodations. Most communal apartments have a shared kitchen, living room and bathroom. You have an individual bedroom and furniture. It is common to pay a deposit of one month's rent and a small contract fee. A **home stay** with a local family is an option, too. Rent is approximately \$170 per month in a single room with breakfast included.



## SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

There are several student interest groups who will introduce you to discussion topics, volunteer work and field trips. Also, when you arrive in Argentina, you will attend an orientation session including a city tour. You will learn about the relevant aspects of academic and leisure activities in Rosario and Argentina. If you get involved, Austral University is a great place to make new friends for life.



## FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

If you participate in this program, you may apply for a **\$750 John Barrett scholarship** for one semester or a **\$1000 John Barrett scholarship** for both fall and spring semesters.

If you need additional financial aid, you should apply through UNF's Student Financial Aid Office.

## COSTS

This is an **EXCHANGE PROGRAM** which means that you pay UNF tuition to study abroad. Existing scholarships (including PrePaid and Florida Bright Future) and financial aid apply.

Tuition fees **do not** include the cost of airfare, local transportation, meals, housing, passport fees, visa fees, personal travel funds, etc.

All study abroad students are required to have specific medical health insurance while outside of the United States. You might be required to purchase supplemental insurance, in addition to your current coverage, to meet UNF coverage requirements.
