There is an additional fee per course for undergraduate courses in the International Business Program (taught in English). Note: 1 course = 275 Euro (approximately. \$438), 3 courses = 650 Euro (approximately. \$1036)

Approximate US\$ costs are based on conversation rate on April 16, 2008 (<http://www.xe.com>) of 1 Euro (EUR) = 1.59 US\$. Students should revisit that site for updated exchange rates.
