# Students

- The College enrolls over 2,000 students annually and graduates approximately 500 of these per year.
- Students are placed in 2,000 field experiences year, for a total of more than 175,000 hours of applied experience annually.
- Over 75% of our professional education graduates take new positions in schools or already work in schools.
- 100% pass rate on the Florida Teacher Certification Exam.
- 100% eligibility for rehire among graduates in school districts.
- Over 1/3 of teachers in Duval County and ½ of principals received education at UNF.
- Three hundred students enrolled in or have completed an education minor.

# *Partnerships*

- Award-winning professional development school (PDS) programs in 5 area elementary and middle schools.
- Clinical faculty partnership with Duval and Clay Counties.
- Special ESOL center for second language students at West Riverside Elementary.
- Intense early literacy program for preschool children, with focus on professional development those serving these children.
- Ongoing tutoring programs in three schools.
- “Poetry Stars” program.
- Teaching methods courses taught on 12 school sites.
- Faculty designated as “in residence faculty.”

# *Recognitions/Milestones*

- Many COEHS alumni are named “teachers of the year.”
- A COEHS alumnus was given a Presidential award for excellence in teaching in 2006.
- Six doctoral students since 2003 have won awards for their doctoral research.
- In 2005, the College was named a Florida SUCCEED site for alternative teacher certification delivery.
- Fifteen year partnership with the country of Belize—resulting in 300+ UNF alumni in that country.
- College endowment increased by 50% since 2001.
- Number of endowed scholarships has doubled in past five years.
- All programs that can be are accredited.

# *What's New?*

- Students can complete a portion of their teacher education or sport management internships in another country.
- COEHS has applied for designation as an “Educator Preparation Institute.”
- Currently working with Duval County and the Schultz Center to develop enhanced professional development for school leaders and teacher mentors.
- College reorganization in 2006-2007.
- Faculty hiring—we are restaffing our College with talented men and women across all our disciplines (40% new faculty in last three years).
