Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By the year 2005, to decrease by 23% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the *Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey* (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS is 19.5%.

By the year 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol and marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the FYSAS. The baseline statistics from the 2000 FYSAS are 28.7% and 13.5% respectively.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of discipline referrals for students in grades K-8 (per 1,000 students), as measured by school disciplinary records. Baseline statistics from 1999-2000 school disciplinary records show a total of 976 disciplinary referrals for grades K-8, or 783 referrals per 1,000 students (198 or 51 referrals per 100 students for grades K-4 and
