Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the *Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey* (FYSAS). According to the 2000 FYSAS, the baseline data showed that current use (past 30 days) of cigarettes was 15.4% among grade 6-8 students and 25.1% among grade 9-12 students.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of students in grades K-4 per 100 who are referred for fighting, as reported in school discipline referral reports. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 discipline referral reports is 907, or 76 incidents per 100 students in a K-4 population of 1,196.
