**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use or possession of tobacco products, as measured by the *Florida Youth Tobacco Survey* (FYTS). The baseline percentage for current use of tobacco (past 30 days) was 17.1% among students in grades 6-8 and 31.8% among students in grades 9-12, as measured by the 2000 FYTS.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use (past 30 days) of alcohol, as measured by the *Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey* (FYSAS). The baseline percentage for students in grades 6-12 who reported current use (past 30 days) of alcohol from the FYSAS is 29.3%.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of bus infraction incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as measured by the *District Incident Summary Report*
