ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the number of student drug incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-9 and 12, as measured by the 2004-2005 Calhoun District Discipline Report (CDDR). According to the 1999-2000 CDDR, the baseline statistic is 11.3 drug incidents per 1,000 students, in grades 6-9 and 12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the number of student tobacco incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-9 and 12, as measured by the 2004-2005 Calhoun District Discipline Report (CDDR). According to the 1999-2000 CDDR, the

baseline statistic is 13.8 tobacco incidents per 1,000 students, in grades 6-9 and 12.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the number of student fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades K-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 Calhoun District Discipline Report (CDDR). According to the 1999-2000 CDDR, the baseline statistic is 7.2 fighting incidents per 1,000 students, in grades K-12.
