Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (last 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes is 20.8%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (last 30 days), as measured by the FYSAS. According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students

in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol is 29.9%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of discipline referrals for fighting and harassment in grades K-12, per 1,000, as measured by 2004-2005 school discipline records. According to 1999-2000 school discipline records, the baseline statistic for fighting incidents in grades K-12 is 90 incidents per 1,000 students, the baseline statistic for incidents of fighting without injury in grades K-12 is 147 incidents per 1,000 students, and the baseline for harassment is 50 referrals per 1000 students.
