Project Goals

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, we will reduce the number of referrals per 100 students for physical aggression in grades K-8 by 10%, as measured by the 2004-2005 discipline referral data. According to the 1999-2000 discipline referral data, the number of referrals for physical aggression per 100 students for grades K-8 was 21.7.

By June 30, 2005, there will be a 10% increase in the percentage of students in grades 3-8 who report experiencing a safe and orderly school environment as indicated by the School Effectiveness Questionnaire (SEQ). According to the 1999-2000 SEQ, the current percentage of students in grades 3-8 who report experiencing a safe and orderly environment was 63% (baseline statistic).
