Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 26.6% in grades 6-12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 24.1%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 41.1%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 10% the number of incidents of fighting per 1,000 students in grades PK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). The baseline statistic was 30.09 incidents per 1,000 students, as measured by the 1999-2000 SESIR for students in PK-12.
