Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the baseline statistic for students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days) was 33.1%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the baseline statistic for students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of marijuana (past 30 days) was 11.5%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% percent the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of cigarettes (past 30 days) was 14.0%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of fighting incidents per 1000 for students, grades K-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 (School Environmental Safety Incident Report SESIR) data. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 SESIR data the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 for students in grades K-12 was 19.91.
