**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2002 FYSAS indicated that 22.3% of students in grades 6-8 students reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days).

By June 30, 2005, to decrease the number of student “drugs except alcohol” incidents by 5% per 1,000 in grades 6-12, district-wide, as measured by the 2004-2005 Calhoun District Discipline Report (CDDR).

According to the 1999-2000 CDDR, the baseline statistic was 11.3 “drugs except alcohol” incidents per 1,000 students, in grades 6-12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease the number of student tobacco incidents by 5% per 1,000 students in grades 6-12, district-wide, as measured by the 2004-2005 Calhoun District Discipline Report (CDDR). According to the 1999-2000 CDDR, the baseline statistic was 16.9 tobacco incidents per 1,000 students, in grades 6-12 district-wide.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, decrease the number of student fighting incidents per 1,000 by 5%, K-12, district-wide as measured by the 2004-2005 Calhoun District Discipline Report (CDDR). According to the 1999-2000 CDDR, the baseline statistic was 8.3 fighting incidents per 1,000 students, in grades K-12.
