**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 42.4%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 26.6%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 19.1%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of any illicit drug excluding marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 14.1%.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of threat and intimidation incidents per 1000 for students in grades PreK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 SESIR. According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the number of threat and intimidation incidents per 1,000 for students in grades PreK-12 was .87.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of fighting incidents per 1000 for students in grades PreK-12, as measured by 2004-2005 county TERMS data. According to 1999-2000 TERMS data, the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 for students in grades PreK-12 was 36.
