Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 33.3%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 15.4%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of any illicit drug excluding marijuana (past 30 days), as

measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 18.9%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 30% the number of incidents per 1,000 of students in grades K-12 who commit violent acts against other persons, as measured by 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incidents Report (SESIR) data. The baseline statistic from 1999-2000 SESIR data was .69 incidents per 1,000 students.

By June 30, 2005, for students in grades K-12, to have reduced by 20% the number of threat and intimidation incidents based on 2004-2005 SESIR data. The baseline SESIR data for the 1999-2000 school year was 8.28 incidents per 1000.

By June 30, 2005, for students in grades K-12, to have reduced by 20% the number of fighting incidents based on 2004-2005 SESIR data. The baseline SESIR data for the 1999-2000 school year was 13.95 incidents per 1000.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the number of disorderly conduct incidents for students in grades 6-12, based on 2004-2005 SESIR data. The baseline SESIR data for the 1999-2000 school year was 113.41 incidents per 1000.
