Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the number of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 35.7%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the number of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 15.5%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the number of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 22.7%.

Violence Prevention

By the June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 SESIR showed a rate of 22.38 fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12.

By the June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the number of disorderly conduct incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 SESIR. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 SESIR showed a rate of 17.41 disorderly conduct incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12.
