Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 10% the number of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 23.2% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use of cigarettes (past 30 days).

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 10% the number of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 30.6% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days).

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 10% the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as indicated by the 2004-2005 district School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). The 1998-1999 SESIR indicated there were 110.93 incidents of fighting per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 10% the number of threat and intimidation incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as indicated by the 2004-2005 district School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). The 2000-2001 SESIR indicated there were 13.96 incidents of threat and intimidation per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12.
