Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 40% the number of incidents of tobacco use reported per 1,000 students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). According to the 2000-2001 SESIR, there were 10.48 tobacco incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 reported for alcohol use, as measured by the 2004-2005 district Information Systems Discipline Report (ISDR). According to the 1999-2000 ISDR, 14.7% of students in grades 6-12 reported alcohol use.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of incidents of other drug use per 1,000 students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 SESIR. According to the 2000-2001 SESIR, there were 3.22 incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-12 of other drug use.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 30% the number of incidents of violence per 1,000 students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 ISDR. According to the 1999-2000 ISDR, there were 91 incidents of violence per 1,000 students in grades 6-12.
