**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report binge drinking, as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported binge drinking was 21.7%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the baseline statistic for students in grades 6-12

who reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days) was 35.7%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report having used cigarettes in the past 30 days, as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported cigarette use in the past 30 days was 20.4%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report having used methamphetamines in the past 30 days, as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported methamphetamine use in the past 30 days was 2.4%.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades K-12, as reported by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the baseline statistic for fighting incidents in grades K-12 was 21.01 per 1,000 students.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of threat and intimidation incidents per 1,000 students in grades K-12, as reported by the 2004-2005 SESIR. According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the baseline statistic for threat and intimidation incidents in grades K-12 was 8.73 per 1,000 students.
