Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 2000 FYSAS, the baseline statistic was 34.3%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the FYSAS. According to the 2000 FYSAS, the baseline statistic was 21.1%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of reported incidents of fighting per 1,000 students in grades PK-12, as measured

by the 2004-2005 School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR) data. According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the number of fighting incidents per 1000 for students, grades PK-12 was 26.47.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of reported incidents for sexual harassment per 1,000 students in grades PK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 Leon County School Crime and Violence Survey (SCVS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 SCVS was 1.38 incidents per 1,000 students in grades PK-12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the number of reported incidents of weapon's possession incidents per 1,000 students in grades PK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environment Safety Incident Report (SESIR) data. According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the number of weapon's possession incidents per 1000 for students, grades PK-12 was 2.02.

By June 30, 2005, to reduce or sustain less than 2% incidence the number of violent acts against children for grades K-12, as measured by 2004-2005 Department of Health Child Protective Investigations Report for Leon County. According to the 2002-2003 report, 1.19% of children ages 0-18 were victims of criminal abuse.
