Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who reported current use of cigarettes (past 30 days) was 16%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the percentage of students in grades 9-12 who report current use of smokeless tobacco (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004 FYSAS. According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 9-12 who

reported current use of smokeless tobacco (past 30 days) was 14%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the percentage of students in grades 9-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004 FYSAS. According to the 2002 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 9-12 who reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days) was 43.7%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 5% the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004 FYSAS. According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days) was 10.7%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to maintain the number of fighting incidents in grades K-12, district-wide, as measured by the 2004-2005 Liberty District Discipline Report (LDDR). According to the 1999-2000 LDDR, the number of fighting incidents in grades K-12, district-wide, was zero.
