**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of cigarettes (past 30 days) was 24.1%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the FYSAS. According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days) was 43.7%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report binge drinking (five or more drinks at one sitting), as measured by the FYSAS. According to the 2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported binge drinking was 27.1%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 2000-2001 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of marijuana (past 30 days) was 25.1%.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades K-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 SESIR. According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades K-12 was 9.45.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 8 percent the percentage of students in grades 6-12 with favorable attitudes toward ATOD use, as measured by the Risk and Protective Factors of the FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was a scale score of 54.
