**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 29.7% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use of alcohol.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report binge drinking (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 14.6%

of students in grades 6-12 reported binge drinking.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 10.0% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use of cigarettes.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of smokeless tobacco (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 3.2% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use of smokeless tobacco.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 8.9% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use of marijuana.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of any illicit drug excluding marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, 7.1% of students in grades 6-12 reported current use any illicit drug excluding marijuana.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to reduce by 16% the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-12 was 44.93.

By June 30, 2005, to reduce by 16% the number of weapons possession incidents per 1,000 students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 SESIR. According to the 1999-2000 SESIR, the number of weapons
