Project Goals

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). According to the 1998-1999 SESIR, the number of fighting incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12 was 28.85.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of threats and intimidation incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School

Environmental Safety Incident Report (SESIR). According to the 1998-1999 SESIR, the number of threats and intimidation incidents per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12 was 11.11.

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days) as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 25.9% in middle school and 59.9% in high school.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported "binge drinking" as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 8.4% in middle school and 38.9% in high school.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days) as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 8.8% in middle school and 29.7% in high school.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days) as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 9.7% in middle school and 25.7% in high school.
