Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of all tobacco products (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Tobacco Survey (FYTS). The baseline statistics from the 2000-2001 FYTS were 8.1% for middle school students and 17.9% for high school students.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 2000-2001 FYSAS indicated that 30.1% of students in

grades 6-12 students reported current use of alcohol (past 30 days).

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 15% the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who report current use of illicit drugs (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS indicated that 14.2% of students in grades 6-8 students reported current use of illicit drugs including alcohol and tobacco (past 30 days).

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students per 1,000 in grades PreK-12 who are involved in fighting, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incidents Report (SESIR). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 SESIR was 36.64 incidents of fighting per 1,000 students in grades PreK-12.
