**Project Goals**

***ATOD Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of incidents of drug possession or use per 1,000 students in grades K-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incidents Report (SESIR). According to the 2000-2001 SESIR, the number of incidents of drug possession or use was 2.73 per 1,000 students in grades K-12.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the percentage of students in grades 9-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the Florida Youth Substance Abuse (FYSAS). According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the percentage of

students in grades 9-12 who reported current use of marijuana was 20.2%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 15% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. According to the 1999-2000 FYSAS, the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who reported current use of cigarettes was 17.5%.

***Violence Prevention***

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 20% the number of incidents of fighting per 1,000 students in grades K-12, as measured by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incidents Report (SESIR). According to the 2000-2001 SESIR, the number of incidents of fighting was 20.53 per 1,000 students in grades K-12.
