Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of alcohol (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 33.0%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of cigarettes (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS is 21.7%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 15.2%.

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 50% the percentage of students in grades 6-12 who report current use of any illicit drug excluding marijuana (past 30 days), as measured by the 2004-2005 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 10.3%.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to reduce the number of incidents of scuffling, or horseplay, by 25% by students in grades PK-12 as measured by 2004-2005 discipline referrals. The baseline statistic from the 2001-2002 discipline report was 37.9 cases per 1,000 students.

By June 30, 2005, to reduce the number of fighting incidents per 1000 for students in grades PK-12 as indicated by the 2004-2005 School Environmental Safety Incidents Report (SESIR). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 SESIR was 3.79 cases per 1,000 students.

By June 30, 2005, to reduce by 15% the percent of absenteeism by students in grades K-12 in three targeted schools as indicated by the 2004-05 Attendance Report. The baseline statistic from the 2002-2003 Attendance Report is unavailable.

By June 30, 2005, to reduce by 10% the percentage of students in grades K-8 in 25 targeted schools who report being bullied as measured by the 2004-2005 Colorado School Climate Post-test. The baseline statistic from the 2001-2002 Colorado School Climate Pre-test is unavailable.
