Project Goals

ATOD Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to increase the mean age of first use of alcohol by 2.5 years among students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2006 Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS). The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 12.2 years.

By June 30, 2005, to increase the mean age of first use of tobacco by 2.5 years among students in grades 6-12, as measured by the 2006 FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 1999-2000 FYSAS was 11.6 years.

By June 30, 2005, to increase the mean age of first use of marijuana by 2.5 years among

students in grades 6-12 as measured by the FYSAS. The baseline statistic from the 2000 FYSAS was 12.7 years.

Violence Prevention

By June 30, 2005, to decrease by 25% the percentage of students in grades K-12 who receive discipline referrals for disrespectful behavior, as measured by 2004-2005 Wakulla County District discipline reports. According to the 1999-2000 Wakulla County District discipline reports, the percent of students referred for disrespectful behavior was 10%.
