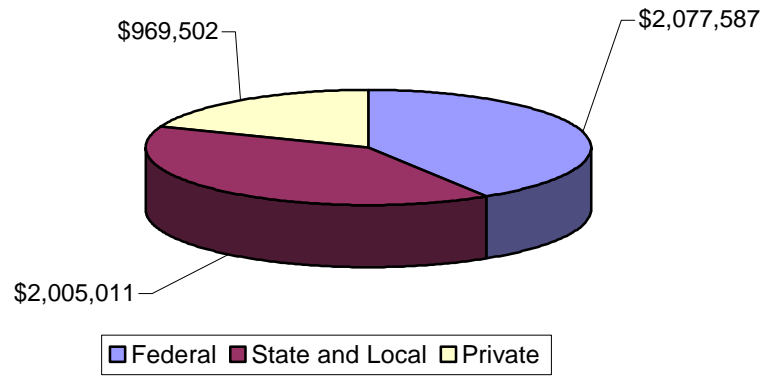

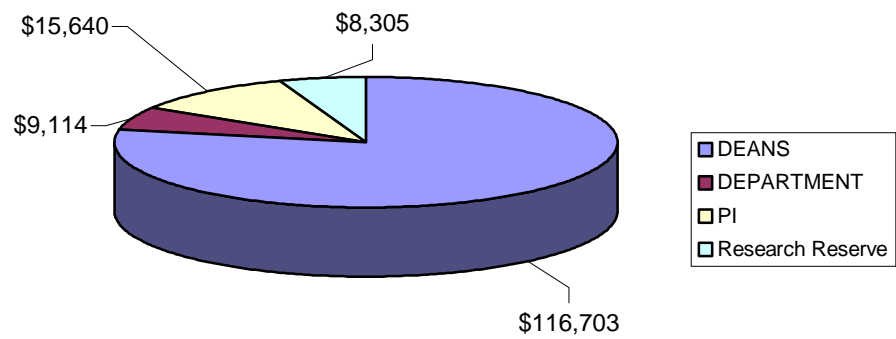

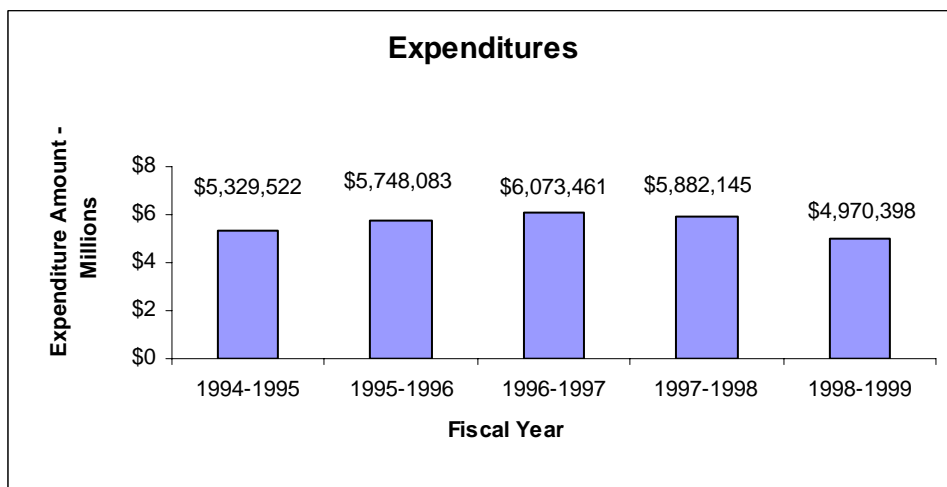
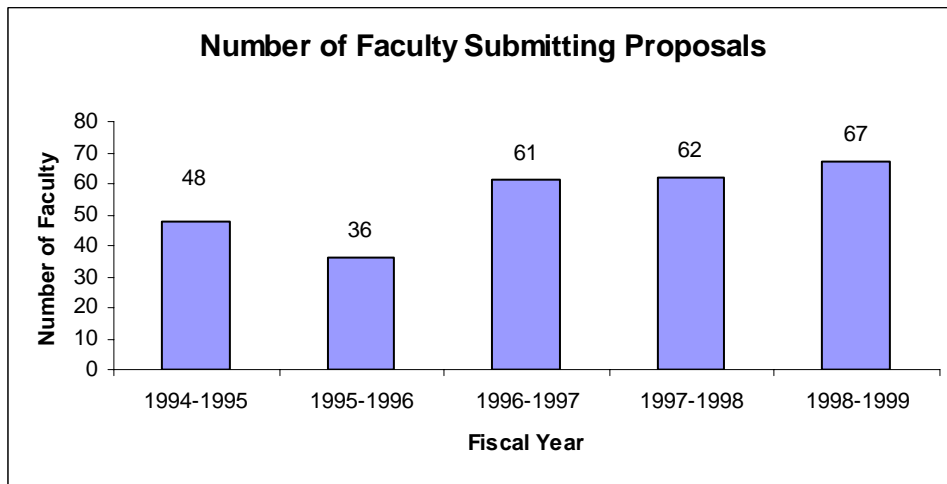
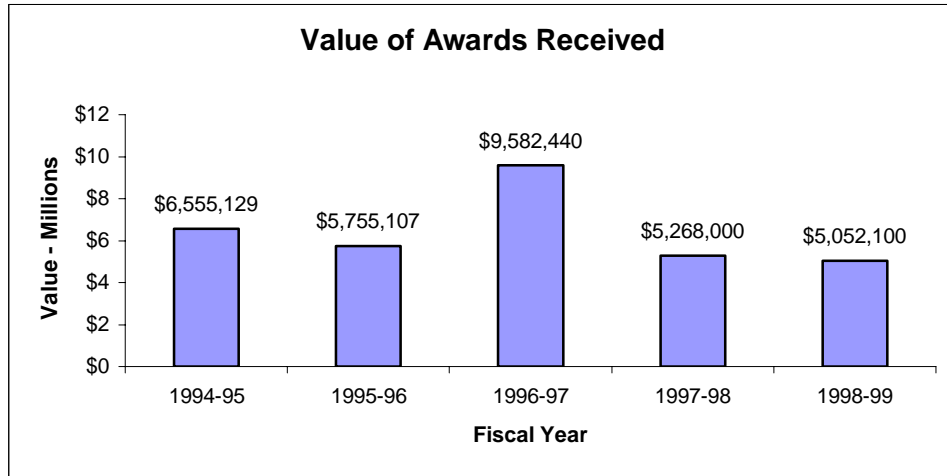
Sources of Funding for Contracts and Grants

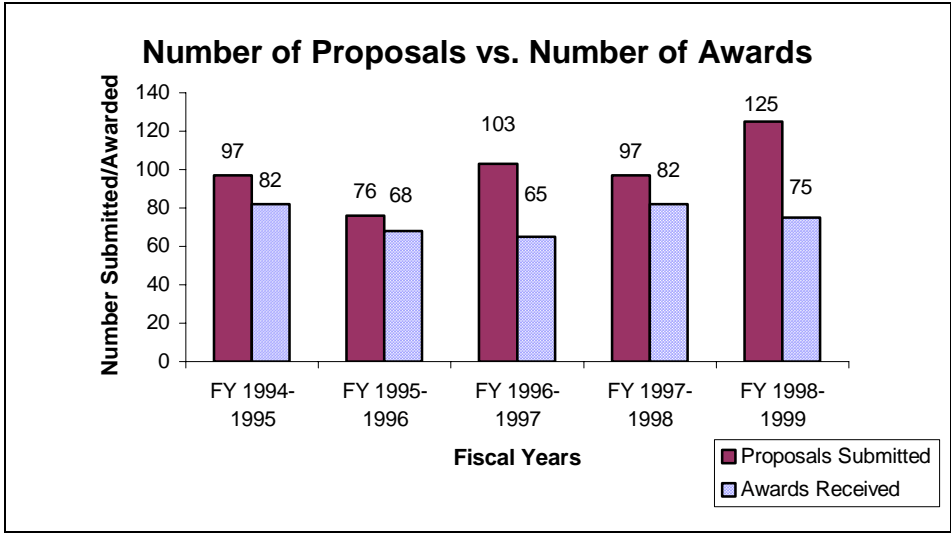


Facilities and Administrative (Indirect) Cost Revenue Distribution
