Summer Requirements:

The above student has been admitted to the University of North Florida's Academic Potential Program for the Summer B Term. In order to continue taking classes and be admitted to UNF as a freshman for Fall term, the student agrees to the following conditions:

A) Student must complete Option 1 or Option 2:

Option 1: Student must register for two academic courses at UNF during the Summer B term.

OR

Option 2: Student must register for one academic course and a **College Preparatory Math Workshop** during Summer B term. **Math Workshop is mandatory for students who complete the Florida College Entry Level Placement Test (CPT) and place into Elementary or Intermediate Algebra.**

B) Student must earn:

Option 1: A minimum of a "C" grade in **each** academic course

OR

Option 2: A minimum of a "C" grade in **each** academic course **AND** a "pass" grade for Math Workshop

C) Student must register for, attend and earn a "C" or higher grade in a weekly mandatory 1.0 credit hour First Year Seminar.

D) Student agrees to access their UNF e-mail. **E-mail is the official mode of communication for the university.** See the office of Information Technology Services for assistance accessing this account. It is the student's responsibility to check his/her messages.

E) Student agrees to authorize the Academic Center for Excellence (ACE) to contact and discuss the student's academic progress with his/her legal guardian during the summer and fall semesters.

F) Student agrees to attend a welcome to fall program (Date to be determined).

G) Student understands that **six (6)** semester hours are required to receive federal and state financial aid (see Office of Financial Aid) during summer B. Math Workshop is a non-credit course and does not count for financial aid purposes.

H) Student agrees to attend regularly scheduled meetings with their assigned academic advisor from the Academic Center for Excellence. Students must meet with their advisor at least twice in the summer term and attend one Study Skills Workshop.

I) There will be no exceptions or appeals to meeting the above criteria in determining admission for Fall.

Fall requirements:

J) Student will attend weekly advisor meetings or scheduled events as determined by your advisor. Students will be expected to participate in formation of an academic success plan to include academic goals, time management and application of study skills.

K) Students failing to comply with the fall requirement will be unable to enroll in the spring semester.
