Completing the application process by this deadline (assuming sufficient enrollment) will result in aid disbursing during the first disbursement cycle (see below). Those who do not meet the published priority deadline will be expected to pay for educational expenses from their own resources until eligibility is established. Applying by this deadline means charges for tuition and fees will be deferred against anticipated financial aid awards. <p>Payment Deadline and Deadline to Add / Drop Courses: Payment deadlines are established for every semester regardless of financial aid. These deadlines coincide with the end of the Add/Drop period for each semester. Students enrolled in courses beyond these dates are considered fee-liable and responsible for the charges. Students who have not paid or do not have pending financial aid posted on myWings will be dropped from their courses for non-payment.
