Budget:

The budget that had been approved at the Executive Council meeting was verbally presented by Cheryl Frohlich, Chapter President. Cheryl explained the following items in the budget.

- The chapter will do a financial review every year when the treasurer changes. This year's was done by a CPA unaffiliated with the union.
- A new budget item that will be reoccurring is bargaining expenses. Since bargaining has now become local, the expenses of bargaining must be accounted and budgeted for in the calendar year
- The need to localize union data and material is necessary so that everyone (given any disclosure limitations) may have access to the data source. In order to organize about 10 years of material, a person will be hired to help in the organization and to set up the office.
- The state is requiring the local chapter to pay part of costs for the professional consultant from state union, majority of team thought it was important and necessary
