**SWOOP Scholarship**

- **\$8,000 over 4 years (\$2,000 per academic year)**
- The **SWOOP Scholarship Program** was developed to demonstrate UNF's strong commitment to providing financial support and meaningful experiences for eligible applicants from designated high schools.
- For the 2007-2008 academic year, UNF has partnered with the following **SWOOP High Schools**:

**Eligibility** *To be considered for this scholarship, the candidate must:*

- ✓ Earn admission to UNF for either the summer or fall 2008 term as a first-time-in-college freshman and as a full-time student.
- ✓ Must graduate from one of the designated "SWOOP" high schools.

**Eligible students who are admitted to UNF from one of the 2007-2008 designated "SWOOP High Schools" should apply to UNF by the April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 priority deadline. Students who submit a UNF application after the deadline will be reviewed on a funds-available basis.**

**\$20,000**

**Osprey Outreach Scholarship**

- **\$20,000 over 4 years (\$5,000 per academic year)**
- One student from each of four community organizations in the Jacksonville area will be eligible to receive this award.
- For the 2007-2008 academic year, UNF has partnered with the following Jacksonville area organizations:

- *Black Achievers (YMCA)*
- *Urban League*
- *The First Baptist Church of Mandarin*
- *100 Black Men - Jacksonville*

**Eligibility** *To be considered for this scholarship, the candidate must:*

- ✓ Rank in the top 50 percent (or comparable level) of their senior class.
- ✓ Be nominated by a high school college coordinator or guidance counselor.
- ✓ Graduate from high school in 2008, be accepted at UNF and begin their studies during the same calendar year
- ✓ Be entering their freshman year at the University of North Florida in the summer or fall of 2008 as a full-time student.
- ✓ Have a minimum cumulative overall high school GPA of 3.5

**An official copy of the high school transcript and completed nomination form must be postmarked no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008.**

**Important:** These scholarships are merit-based programs. To be considered for any need-based scholarships (i.e. Pathways to Success Scholarships) or other need-based student aid, students must submit a 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). *The FAFSA is available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). (The FAFSA Application should be received and processed by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 for the FL state aid deadline).*
