PROFESSIONAL SPOTLIGHT: THE PROPELLER CLUB OF JACKSONVILLE

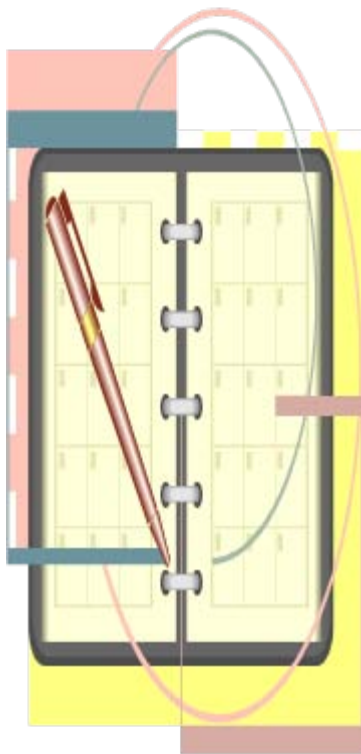
