### JSTOR Arts & Sciences I and II Collection

JSTOR is an archive of the **full text** of over 300 journals in many subject areas. The JSTOR database is unique because the complete backfiles of these core scholarly journals have been digitized, starting with the very first issues, many dating back to the 1800s.

JSTOR does not provide access to current articles. Agreements with publishers include an updating provision referred to as a "moving wall." The moving wall is a fixed period of time ranging, in most cases, from 2 to 5 years, that defines the gap between the most recently published issue and the date of the most recent issues available in JSTOR. UNF may have the full text of the current issues in another database or in print.

### Search Tips and Quick Info

The **Advanced Search** screen offers many options for limiting searches by title, author, etc.

Only about 10% of the articles in JSTOR have abstracts. Use an abstract search cautiously.

You can limit a search by type on the advanced search screen. Select "article" if you don't want book reviews.

JSTOR help screens and tutorials are excellent. There are other search options not listed in this quick reference.
