- RefWorks is available 24/7 through the Internet. No software and no downloads are necessary. <http://www.refworks.com>
- Signup information and links to guides and tutorials are on the library's main page at the bottom of the first column under *Quick Links*. There is a link to RefWorks at the bottom of each database page and the main library page.

- Article citations in RefWorks can link to the full text (if available) through Article Linker.

POSSIBLE USES FOR REFWORKS

- Import article citations to prepare a reference list (bibliography).
- Create a database of interesting articles on a particular topic or by a certain author/researcher to save for future use.
- Use for group collaboration on a project.
- Keep a running bibliography of your works for your vita.
- Import article citations of full text articles for a class reading list. Link to full text from within RefWorks using Article Linker. (No more course reserve copyright problems!)
- Use RefWorks from within Blackboard.
