

Bachelor of Science: Interdisciplinary Sciences

Interdisciplinary Sciences is a legacy program with a curriculum that includes required and elective courses in biology, chemistry, and physics. It is antecedent to, and has been superseded by current programs in these three areas of the natural sciences. Tracks in biology, chemistry and physics programs, with free electives, offer breadth of study in the natural sciences, but require a depth of study in one of the disciplines beyond that required in Interdisciplinary Sciences. Interdisciplinary Sciences is superfluous, poorly subscribed, and intrinsically resistant to assessment for student learning outcomes. As such, the Department of Chemistry and Physics requests that the program in Interdisciplinary Sciences be terminated.
