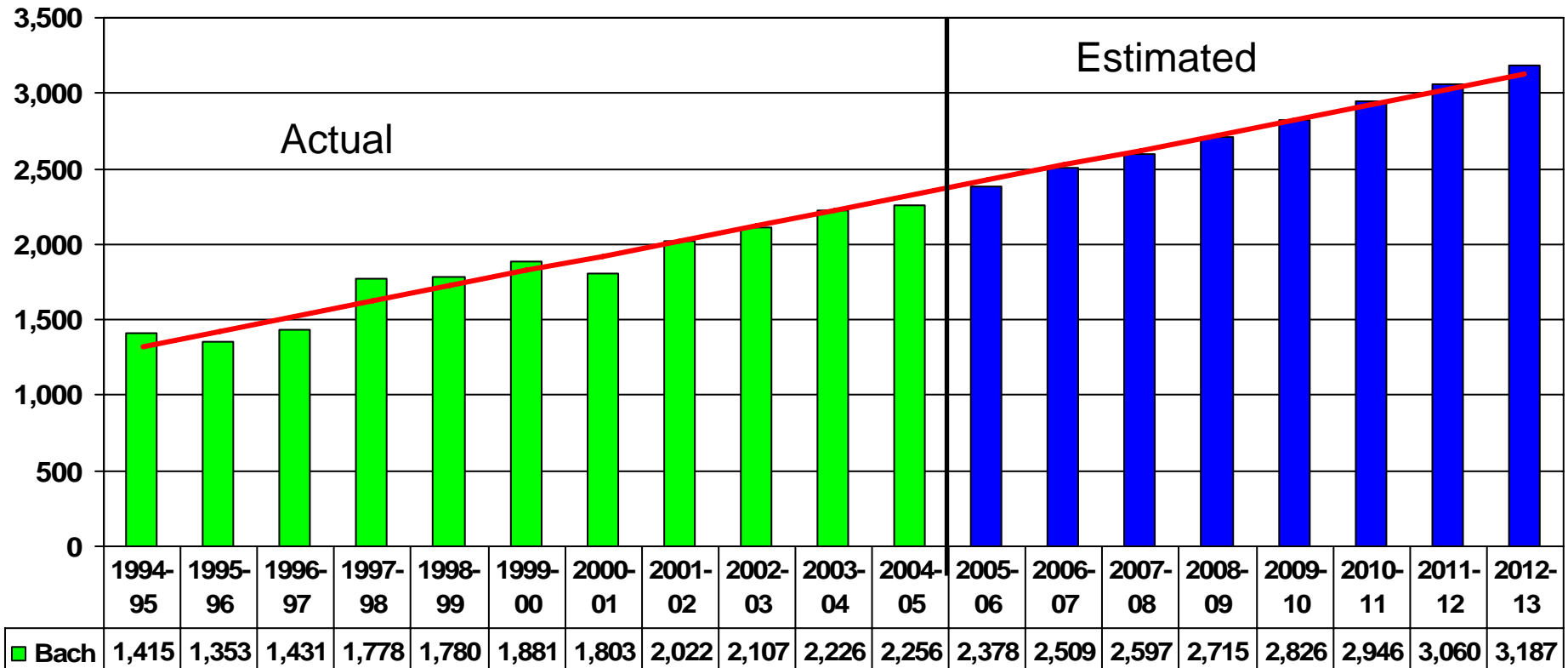
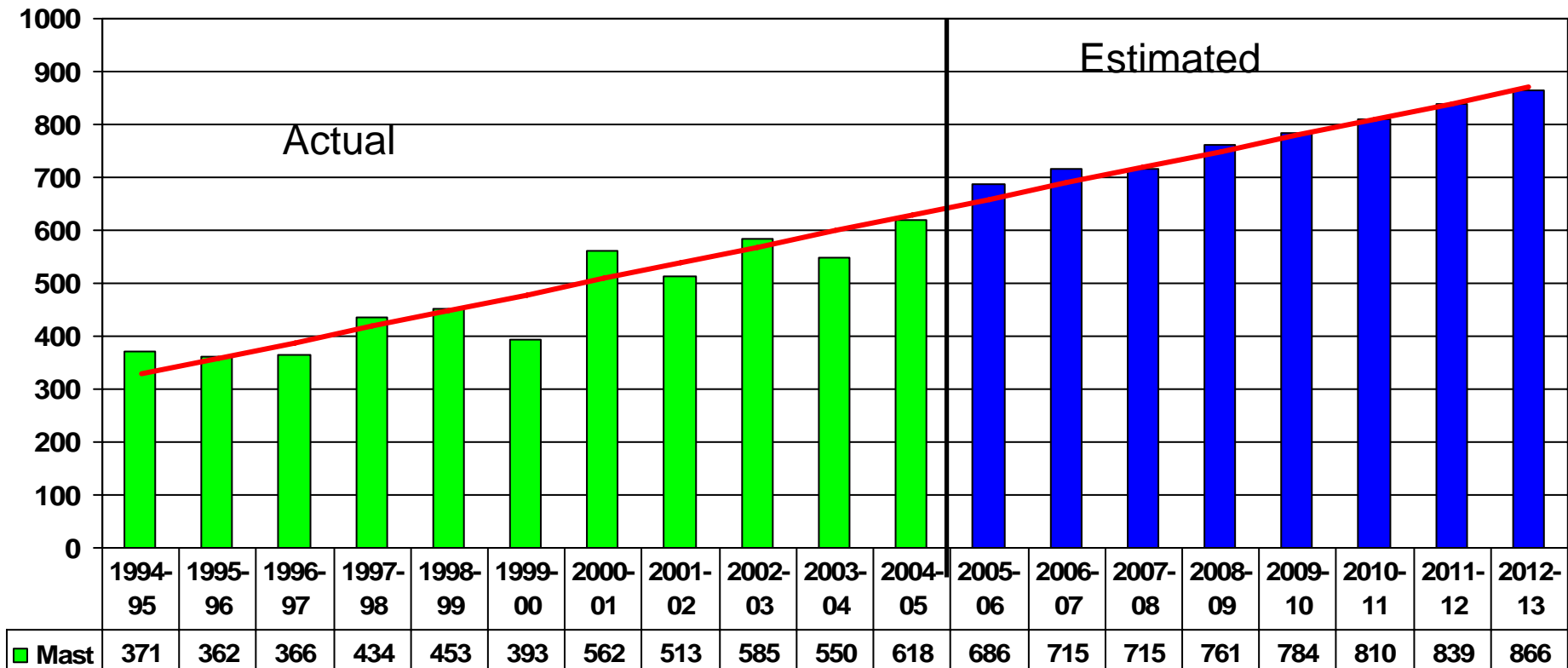


# Baccalaureate Degrees Awarded Actual and Estimated



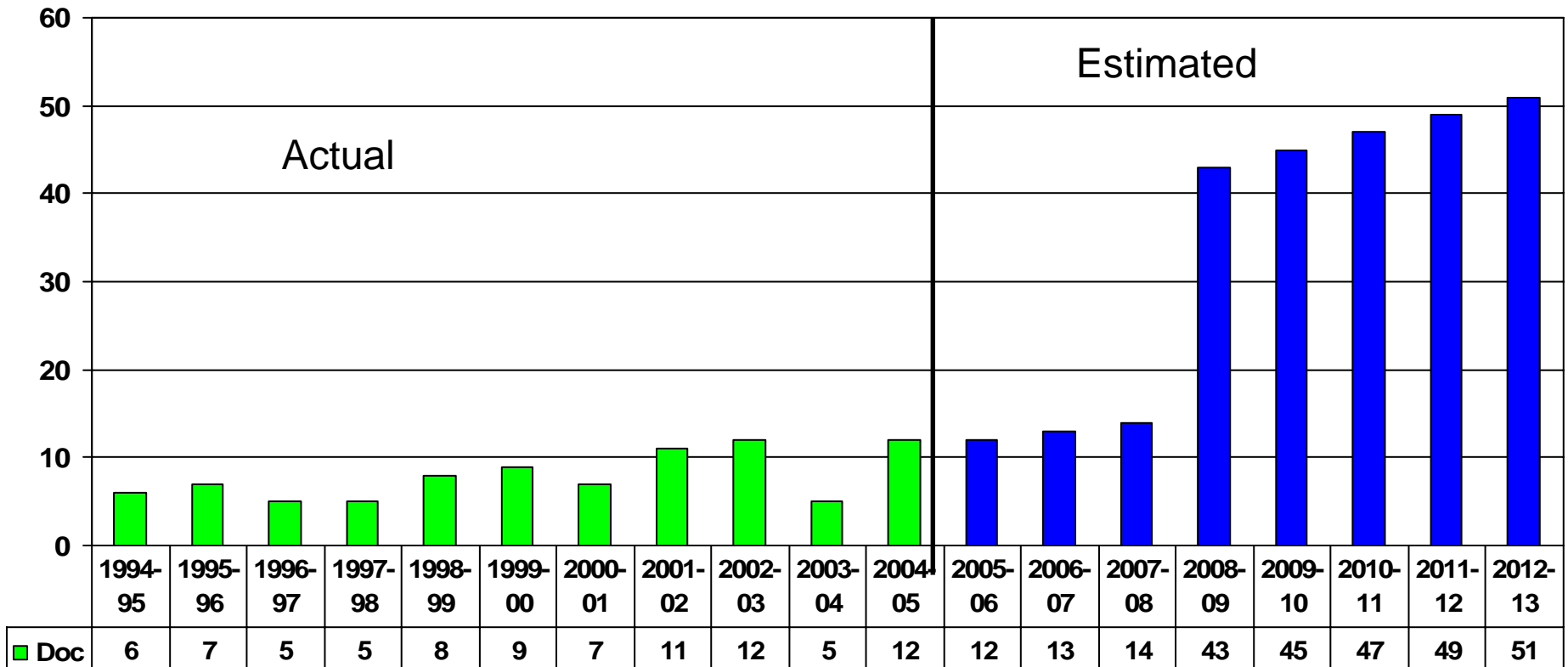

# Masters Degrees Awarded Actual and Estimated



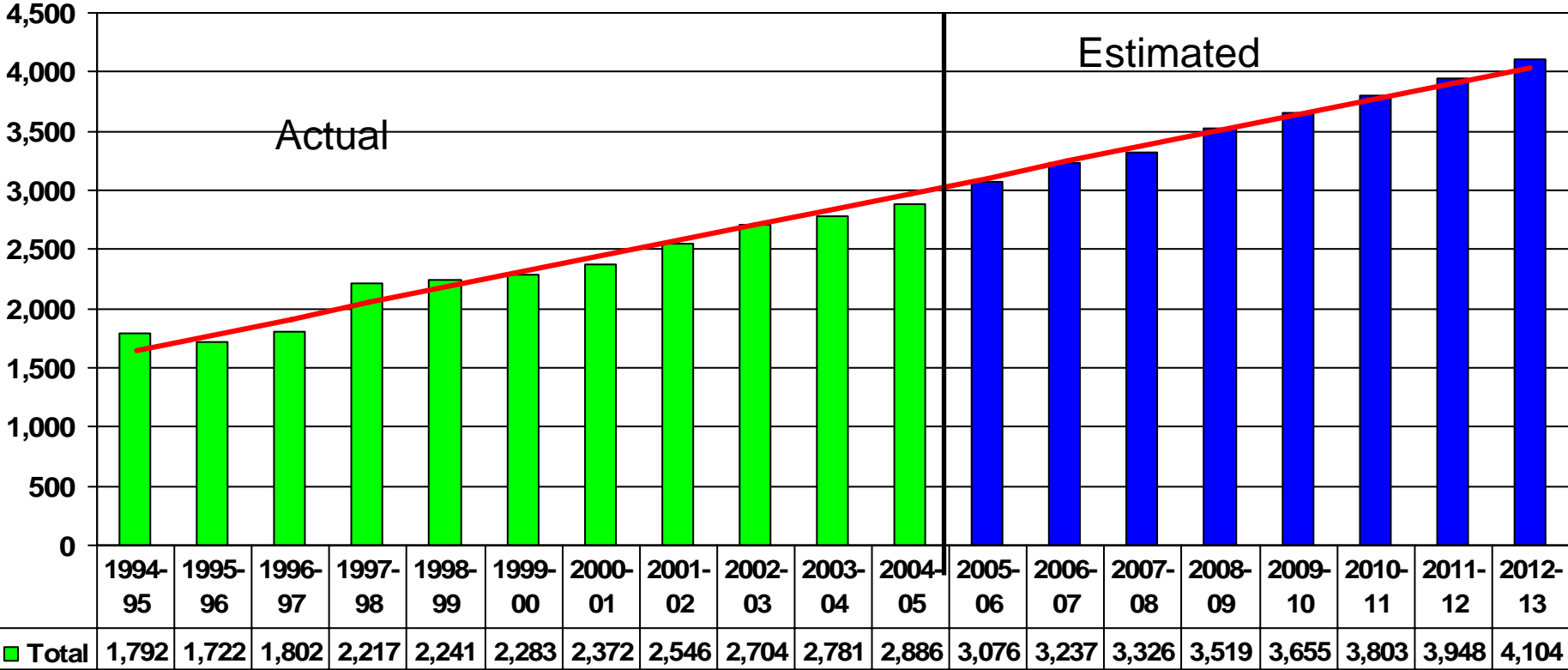

# Total Degrees Awarded Actual and Estimated

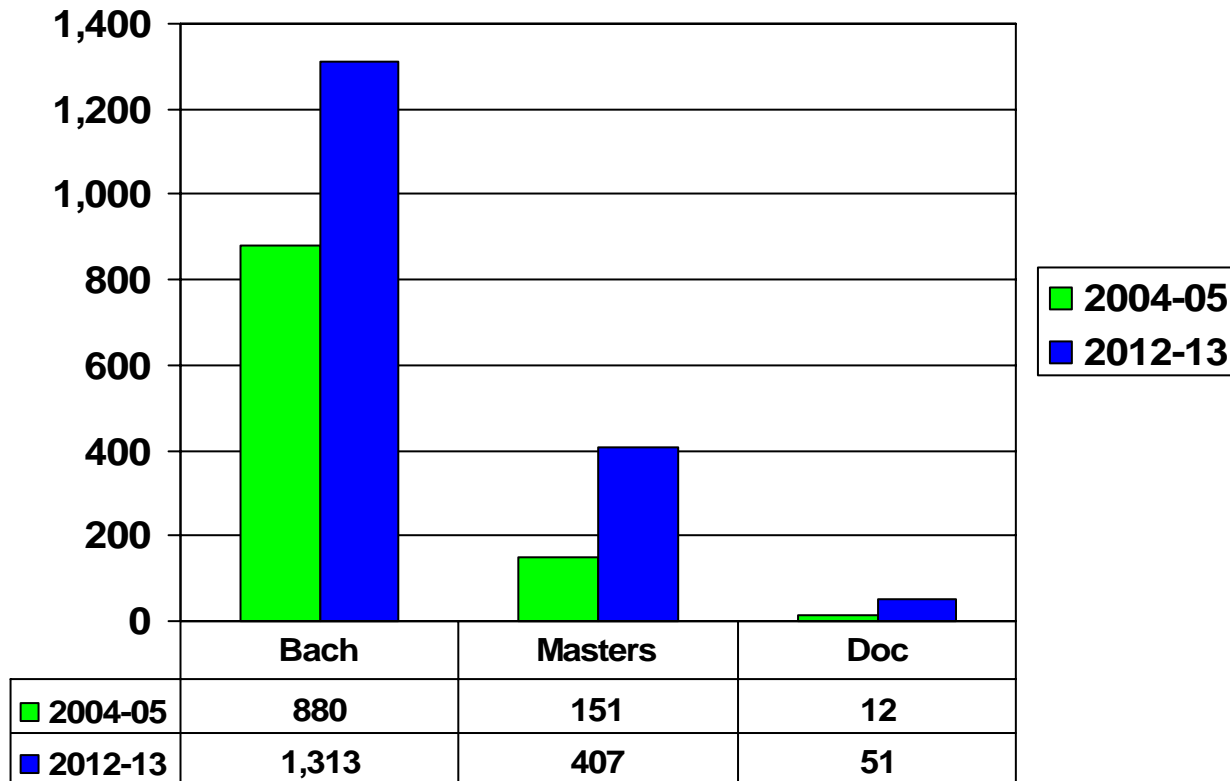

## 2004-05 vs. Estimated 2012-13

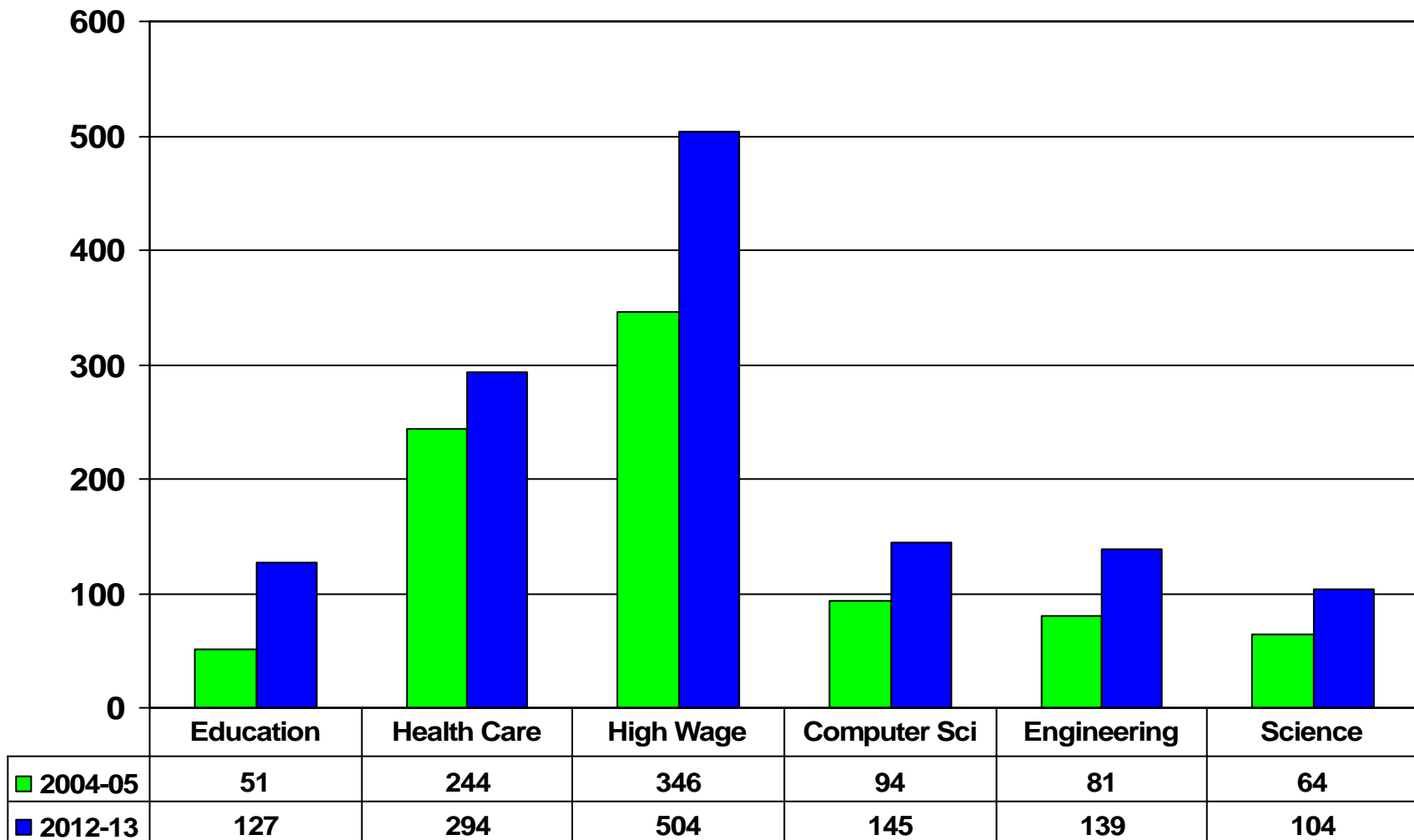
### By Degree Level



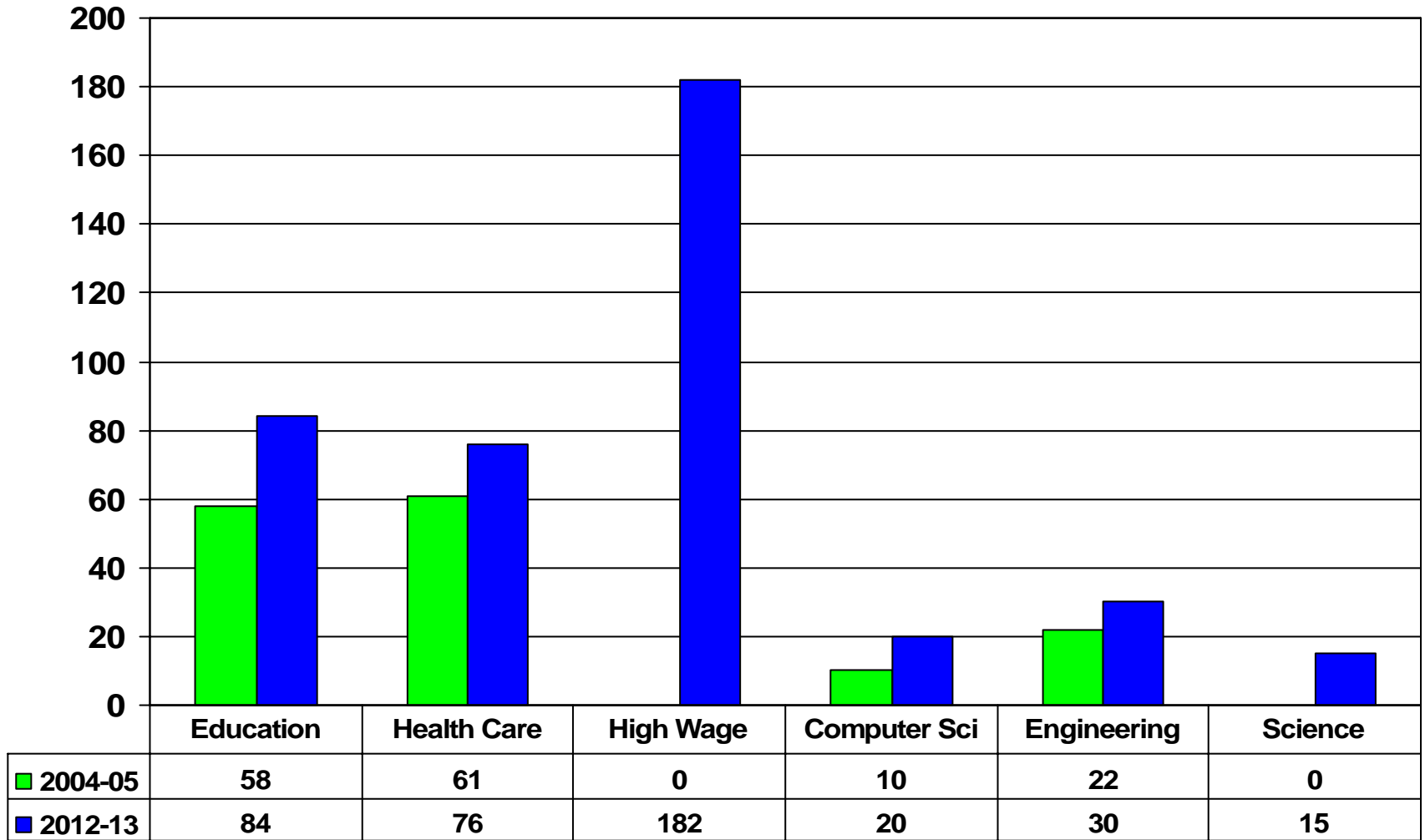

# Baccalaureate Degrees Awarded in BOG Targeted Areas 2004-05 vs. Estimated 2012-13

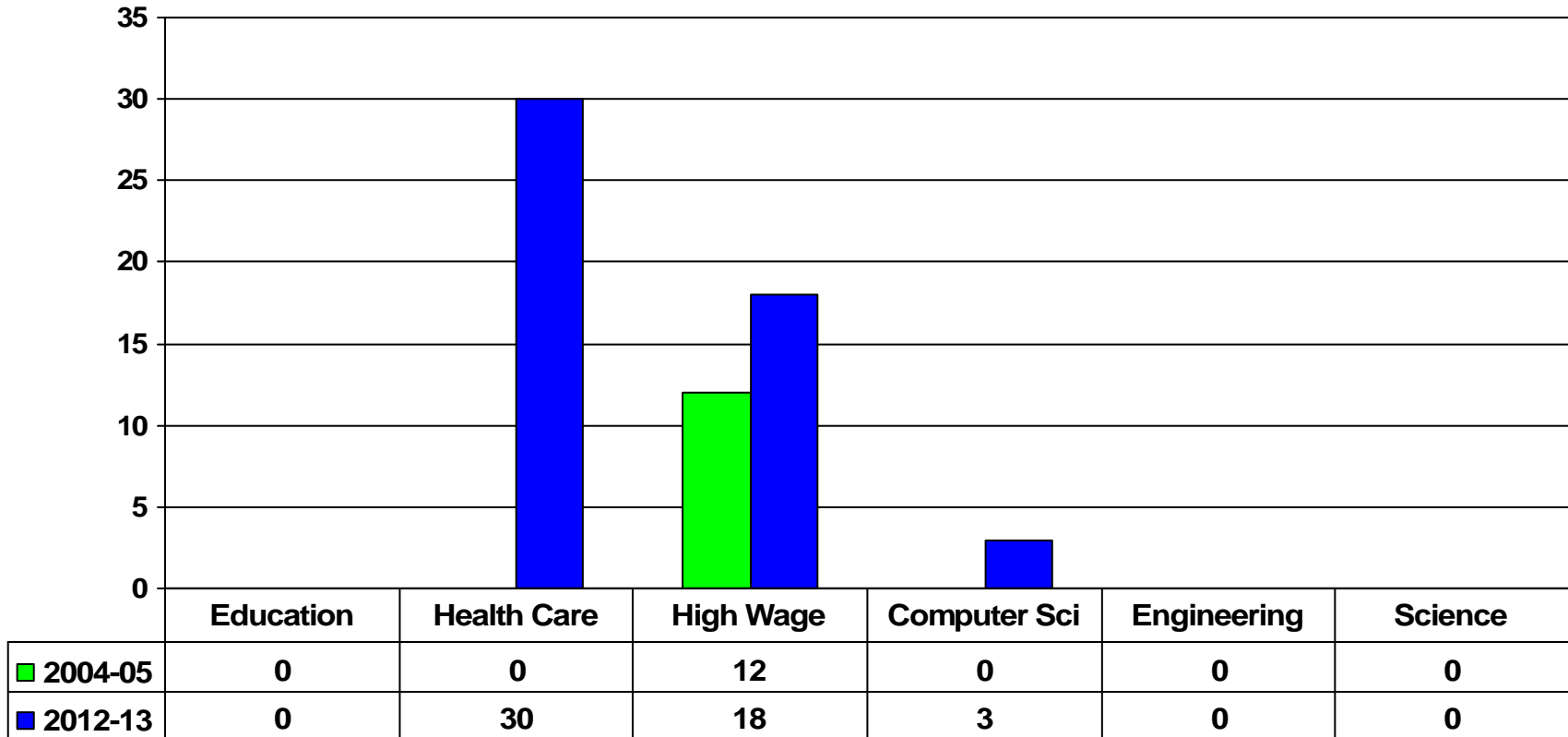


# Masters Degrees Awarded in BOG Targeted Areas 2004-05 vs. Estimated 2012-13
