6C9-8.1006 Waiver of Non-Florida Student Tuition.

(1) The President of the University or his designee is authorized to ~~grant out-of-state tuition waivers to non-Florida students who are admitted to the u~~University and who have demonstrated special skills or attributes which may contribute positively to the academic environment waive tuition and out-of-state fees for purposes which support and enhance the mission of the University and pursuant to policies and procedures approved by the University Board of Trustees. The total number and value of all fee waivers granted for any fiscal year shall not exceed the allocation approved annually by the Board.

(2) The total annual dollars granted shall not exceed the total fee waiver dollars approved for the University by the University of North Florida Board of Trustees in its annual allocation.
