

The GlobalMBA is a unique program providing graduate students the opportunity to combine intensive classroom study with residential experiences in four countries: Germany, Poland, China and the United States. The GlobalMBA is offered by a consortium of four universities: Cologne University of Applied Sciences (Germany), the University of Warsaw (Poland), Dongbei University of Finance and Economics (China) and the University of North Florida (USA). Each school holds accreditation in their respective countries.

***The accreditation listed below for one institution does not extend or apply to another institution in the GlobalMBA program.*** Although the degree granting institutions in the GlobalMBA accept certain transfer course work from the GlobalMBA partner institutions towards a degree, other colleges and universities outside of the GlobalMBA may or may not accept this work in transfer, even if it appears on a transcript from CUAS, UW, DUFE or UNF. This decision is made by the institution subsequently considering the possibility of accepting such credits.

#### **Cologne University of Applied Sciences (CUAS):**

Cologne University of Applied Sciences is accredited by the Accreditation, Certification and Quality Assurance Institute (ACQUIN) for German undergraduate and post graduate degree programs.

#### **University of Warsaw (UW):**

University of Warsaw is accredited by the Polish Accreditation Committee (PKA) and is a full member of the European Consortium for Accreditation (ECA), International Network for Quality Assurance Agencies in Higher Education (INQAAHE) and the European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ENQA).

#### **Dongbei University of Finance and Economics (DUFE):**

Dongbei University of Finance and Economics is a government-sponsored general higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Education in China to offer bachelor, master and doctoral programs.

#### **University of North Florida (UNF):**

The University of North Florida is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges to award baccalaureate, masters, and doctoral degrees.
