### What is my service obligation if I am accepted?

- Be in contact with a recruiter monthly while in school.
- Participate in the Physical Readiness Program every 6 months while in school.
- Serve a minimum of three years on active duty as a Naval Officer.

### What are the requirements?

- Be accepted to, or enrolled in a CAHME, AACSB, or CEPH accredited Masters Degree Program in Healthcare Administration
- Be a U.S. citizen and be physically qualified for commission as a U.S. Naval Officer.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher and a GMAT/GRE score of 525/300.
