



HOW TO ALLOW STUDENTS TO ATTACH VIDEOS IN DISCUSSIONS



1. Log into Canvas
2. Click on *Courses* in the left blue toolbar
3. Click on *Settings* in the white course toolbar
4. Click on *more options* at the bottom of the page

- Let students self-enroll by sharing with them a secret URL
- Let students attach files to discussions
- Let students create discussion topics
- Let students edit or delete their own discussion posts
- Let students organize their own groups
- Hide totals in student grades summary
- Hide grade distribution graphs from students
- Disable comments on announcements

5. Check the appropriate box to allow students to attach files to discussions.
6. You may also want to check boxes to allow students to create discussion topics or to edit/delete their own posts.
7. Click *Update Course Details* when finished.
