Recent graduates require 6 credits plus PAD6946 Internship in Public Administration (3 credits); students with 1+ year of relevant professional experience require 6 credits; and students with 5+ years of managerial experience require 3 credits. Fifteen credits are required for a recent graduate taking the Generalist Option. Electives from outside the MPA program may be approved by the MPA Director.
