CCB Zoom Room FAQ:

1. How do I display the podium computer (or my PowerPoint slides) to the projector screen?

- There are two ways to display the podium computer to the projector, both of which
 requires you to turn on the Telepresence equipment from the guide provided and tapped
 on the desk next to the Crestron tablet.
- The first way to project the computer is by creating a "New Meeting" that will
 automatically create a one time Zoom meeting. You can choose to record that session by
 providing your email address (make sure to double check that you type in your email
 address correctly).
- The second way to project the computer is by joining using the Zoom meeting you have already created by typing in the Meeting ID number and the Passcode. After that, you can proceed the same way as you would if you simply creating a new meeting from the system itself.

2. The previous professor didn't end their Zoom session, what do I do?

There are two screens displayed in the Crestron tablet, you would need to switch to one or the other upon where you need to go. If you are in the Zoom Rooms on the first floor (42: 1101, 1105, 1111, 1113), you will need to tab on the "Home" icon that shows a symbol of a house. If you are in a Zoom Room on the second floor (42: 2105), you will see a line at the top center of the Creston tablet where you would need to slide down to find the "Home" icon and tab on it to switch between screens. Once you are on the screen that displayed the Zoom meeting, please be sure to tab on the red button that shows an icon of a door to end the meeting that the previous professor left.
