August

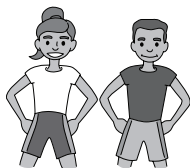


This week we have been reading the book *Corduroy Goes to School*. Ask me to tell you about the different things that Corduroy did at school.

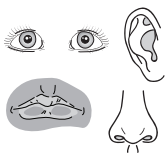


This week we read the book *My Preschool*. Ask me to tell you how the preschool in the book is like my preschool.

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October



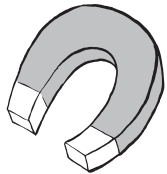
Ask me to describe what science is.

Ask me to tell you about the tools that a scientist uses.

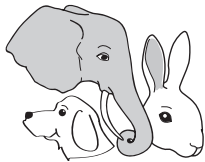

Ask me to show you how two magnets repel each other.

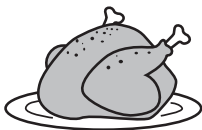
November

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December

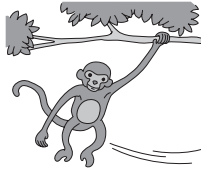


We learned about many places in our neighborhood this week. Ask me to identify two places in our neighborhood.

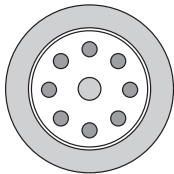


We learned about community helpers. These are people that live in our neighborhoods and help us and protect us. Ask me to identify three community helpers and describe the jobs they do.

January



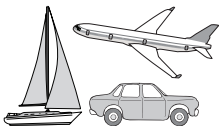
We have been learning about animal movements this week. Ask me to tell and show you five different ways that animals move.

We have been reading the book *Move It! Motion, Forces, and You*. Ask me to tell you at least three ways that I can move things.



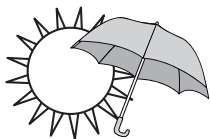
We have been reading the book *Things That Go*. Ask me to tell you about transportation vehicles that travel on the road, on the water, and in the air.

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February



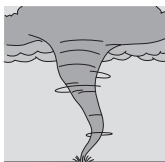
This week we learned about the four seasons of the year.

in this kind of weather and why.

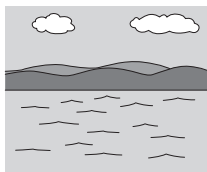


Ask me to tell you about the clothes that I like to wear in different

Ask me to tell you three things I can do to help our world.



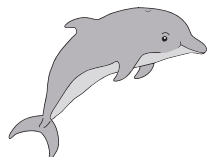
This week we read a book about the importance of

can be recycled.

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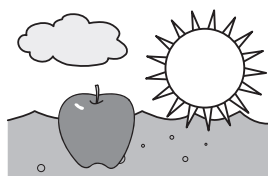
April



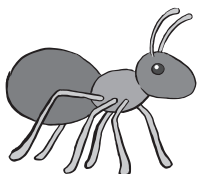

We read a book titled *If a Dolphin Were a Fish* this week. It was a book about water animals. Ask me to tell you the name of three water animals.

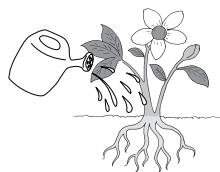


This week we learned about four things that animals and people need to survive. Ask me what they are. (water, air, food, light)

This week we read *My Garden*. Ask me to describe the real and pretend items that the little girl grew in her garden.



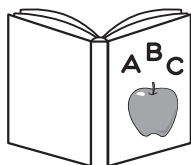
This week we read a book called *Plant Secrets*. Ask me to tell you about the secrets of seeds and plants.
