The Head of Household filing status is for unmarried individuals who provide a home for certain other persons. Per the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), a person is considered unmarried for this purpose if any of the following apply:

- Were legally separated according to their state law.
- Were married, but lived apart from their spouse for the entire last 6 months of 2024 and meet the other rules under married persons who live apart.
- Were married to a nonresident alien at any time during the year and did not choose to treat him or her as a resident alien.

____ Paid more than half the cost to run a home in 2024 (rent, mortgage, utilities, etc.).

____ Supported a qualifying person for at least half of 2024. A qualifying person is a child, parent or relative who meets certain conditions that enable you to qualify for Head of Household.

Important: If it is determined that you are legally married and incorrectly filed your taxes as Head of Household for 2024, you will need to file an Amended Federal Income Tax Return (1040X) for the 2024 tax year reflecting the correct tax filing status. Once completed, the FAFSA form will need to be updated accordingly to reflect the 2024 Amended Federal Income Tax Return.
