

## Contract Transfer Process The Flats at UNF

Students currently living at the Flats at UNF have the option of transferring their contract to another UNF student if they would like to move out before the official contract end date. If you are interested in transferring your contract please see the steps that must be taken below:

- 1. Find another UNF student who is able to take over your Flats at UNF contract (No contract transfers after July 1 each contract term).
- 2. Current Flats at UNF residents should then visit the Housing and Residence Life Office on campus (Building 14B) to receive a Contract Transfer Agreement.
- 3. Both students must agree to a date where the Contract Transfer will be official (in regards to payment of the space).
- 4. The incoming student must complete a Housing Contract on the MyHousing Portal (<u>unf.edu/housing</u>).
- 5. Both students must sign the form in order to agree to the Contract Transfer.
- 6. The Contract Transfer Agreement must then be turned into the Housing and Residence Life Office.
- 7. The Housing Office will contact the incoming student when they are able to officially move into the apartment.

Housing and Residence Life does not assume the responsibility of finding a contract transfer for current or potential future residents.
