DIDACTIC PROGRAM IN DIETETICS, BS

Prepares students to pursue the registered dietitian nutritionist (RDN) credential and earn a verification statement required to complete a dietetic internship. The rigorous curriculum is science-based and accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND), the accrediting body of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics. This program can be completed online at the upper level as part of a 120-credit-hour bachelor's degree.

DIETETIC PROFESSIONAL STUDIES, MS

Developed for credentialed registered dietitian nutritionists (RDNs) or students with a bachelor's degree in nutrition and a didactic program in dietetics (DPD) verification statement from an Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND)-accredited program. The curriculum is an excellent option for students attending a stand-alone dietetic internship or who wish to pursue a master's degree before completing their supervised practice.

INTEGRATED GRADUATE NUTRITION, MS

Provides students with a non-nutrition or nutrition-related undergraduate degree with the knowledge to pursue the Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR) credentialing examination and become a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN). The competency-based curriculum includes online didactic coursework and 1,000 hours of on-site supervised experiential learning in the student's city of residence.

CLINICAL NUTRITION, DCN

Designed for registered dietitians seeking an advanced practice doctoral degree with an emphasis on leadership, evidence-based practice and applied research. The personalized curriculum includes a practice residency and dissertationrelated work. Graduates are well-positioned to apply evidence-based knowledge and significantly contribute to their communities through practice, service and lifelong learning.
