PSYCHIATRIC MENTAL HEALTH NURSE PRACTITIONER

Developed for board-certified nurse practitioners to take the Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (Across the Lifespan) Certification through the American Nurses' Credentialing Center (ANCC) or the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Board (AANPCB). The clinical component (1,100 hours for PMHNP DNP and 800 hours for the certificate) focuses on the mental health care needs of individuals and families in various practice settings. This program prepares students for licensure in the state of Florida. To be admitted, students must be located in Florida or intend to seek employment in Florida.
